BRIEF/MINI BIOGRAPHY

Assoc Prof Daniel Goh was educated at the National University of Singapore and underwent subspecialty training in Paediatric Pulmonology and Sleep at Johns Hopkins, USA.

He is Fellow of the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (UK), the American College of Chest Physicians (USA) and the Academy of Medicine, Singapore.

A/Prof Goh is Chair of the Paediatric Cluster at the National University Health System (NUHS) and Senior Consultant at the Paediatric Pulmonary and Sleep Division at the same institution. He is Past-President of the Singapore Paediatric Society and Past-President of the Asean Paediatric Federation.

His clinical interests include childhood respiratory conditions, sleep habits and practices in children across different cultures, sleep-related breathing disorders as well as paediatric bronchology, fiberoptic bronchoscopy and vaccinology.

Amongst his awards is the Young Investigator's Award at the Singapore-Malaysian Congress of Medicine in 1994 and the prestigious NUHS-Mochtar Riady Pinnacle Awards for Excellence in 2015.
