BRIEF/MINI BIOGRAPHY

Prof. Dr. Enver Hasanoğlu was born in Kerkuk, Turkey in 1946. In 1969 he graduated from Istanbul University; Istanbul School of Medicine and in 1973 he completed his residency in Pediatrics at Hacettepe University, Ankara, Turkey.

Prof. Dr. Hasanoğlu is currently holding the positions of Secretary General of the Union of National Pediatric Societies of Turkish Republics (UNPSTR) since 1993; UNICEF Turkey National Committee Member of Directory Board since 1993; Secretary General of Turkish National Pediatric Society since 2003; Secretary General of Union of Middle Eastern and Mediterranean Pediatric Societies (UMEMPS) since 2008; Member of Standing Committee of the International Pediatrics Association (IPA) since 2007 and Member of the Executive Committee of IPAF.

Prof. Dr. Hasanoğlu is a member of European Dialysis and Transplantation Association (EDTA), Middle East Societies for Organ Transplantation (MESOT), European Society for Pediatric Nephrology, Member of Turkish Medical Academy, Turkish Nephrology and Hypertension Association, and President of Azerbaijan-Turkish Foundation.

Prof. Dr. Hasanoğlu is in the editorial boards of the journals such as Turkish Journal of Pediatrics, Journal of Child Health and Diseases, Turkish Clinics, Journal of the Greek Paediatric Society, Journal of Romanian Pediatric Society, Asian Journal of Pediatric Practice.

Azerbaijan State Medical University (Baku), Macedonian St. Climent Ohridski University and Romanian Ovidius University have awarded Dr. Hasanoğlu with the honorary doctorate of their universities. Dr. Hasanoğlu is also the honorary member of American Academy of Pediatrics and honorary Professor of Russian Scientific Center of Children.

Dr. Hasanoğlu has more than 200 publications in English and Turkish, especially in the field of pediatrics and nephrology.

He speaks English and Arabic in addition to Turkish fluently.
