She is a graduate of Faculty of Medicine Universitas Padjadjaran Bandung, and a consultant of Growth and Development-Social Pediatric from Colegium Indonesian Pediatric since 2004. Nowadays she is chief of Ethics Committee Universitas Padjadjaran Bandung, a secretary of Growth and Development-Social Pediatric Working Group for Indonesian Pediatric Society (2017-present), a member of Adverse Event Following Immunization West Java Committee, and an advisor of AEFI for Bio Farma (Indonesian Vaccine Company).

She is a member of International Society of Pediatric Child Abuse and Neglect (ISPCAN), International Association for Adolescent Health (IAAH), and Interntional Society of Social Paediatric and Child Health (ISSOP)

Dr. Meita, since 2000, has succesfully undertaken numerous Growth and Development-Social Pediatric study, develop a screening tool for child abuse in Indonesia, a book for adolescent health. Furthermore she has done several vaccine researchs in Indonesia e.g measless, DTP, BCG, polio, hepatitis B, Hib, seasonal influenza, combined Pentavalent vaccine (DTP/HB/Hib), also participate in multi-country research to develop dengue vaccine in developing countries (CYD14), surveilans pneumococcus, and bOPV.
