BRIEF/MINI BIOGRAPHY

Rini joined the Department of Pediatrics FKUI - RSCM after completing the Education of Pediatricians in 1998. A year later joined the Division of Growth Development - Social Pediatrics, in accordance with his interest since working as a general practitioner in Puskesmas Kampung Dalam - Pontianak, West Kalimantan.

As an educator staff, the main task is “Tri Darma Perguruan Tinggi”, covering Education - teaching, Research and Health services especially children. Everyday besides teaching students, specialist doctor program participants and consultants and doctoral students, Rini is also involved in several studies. Most of the research was conducted in the community, the topics studied included aspects of growth, child development, child behaviour problems, sleep patterns and sleep disorders in children, immunization, and the link between nutritional intake with the development and behavior of children.

Currently Rini is joining APPSA (Asia Pacific Pediatric Sleep Alliance). APPSA is a select group of physicians from the Asia Pacific region who are experts in the field of baby and child sleep. We have come together with the understanding of sleep, and spreading this knowledge to pediatricians and mothers via publications and educational programs.

During this time Rini often become speakers at the national level, and several international forums related to the topic of sleep and other topics about growth development - social pediatric. She lives in Jakarta - Indonesia, is interested in traveling and riding a bike.
