After graduating from Kyoto Prefectural University of Medicine, I completed 5-year pediatric-residency and 2.5-year neonatal-fellowship in Japan (2003-2010), and then 2-year neonatal-fellowship of University of Toronto in Canada (2011-2012). I completed the PhD program of Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics at McMaster University, Hamilton, Canada (2013-2017) while working as a NICU fellow in Sunnybrook Hospital in Toronto. Since June 2017, I have been the Chief of the Division of Neonatology in National Center for Child Health and Development, Tokyo, Japan.

I have conducted neonatal research using national and international databases including Neonatal Research Network Japan (NRNJ), Canadian Neonatal Network (CNN), and International Network for Evaluation of Neonatal Outcomes in neonates (iNEO). Additionally, I have conducted several systematic reviews and meta-analyses. My major research interests are respiratory and circulatory managements and outcomes of preterm infants. Many of my studies were published in high impact journals including JAMA, JAMA Pediatrics, Pediatrics, etc.
