



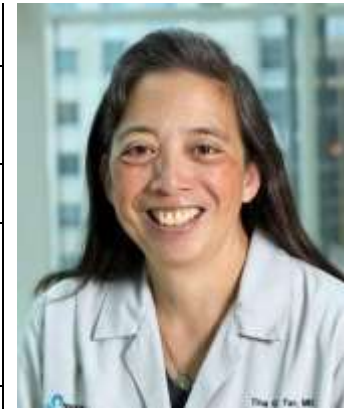

Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago, Chicago, Illinois. She is board certified in Pediatrics and Pediatric Infectious Diseases.

Dr. Tan is the Chairperson of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Section on Infectious Diseases (SOID) and a member of the AAP Committee on Infectious Diseases (COID – Redbook Committee). She serves as a member of the AAP/CDC Global Immunization Advocacy Project Advisory Committee and is a Technical Advisor for Indonesia on the project.
