BRIEF/MINI BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Dung Chi VU is the Head of Department of Medical Genetics, Metabolism and Endocrinology, National Children's Hospital (NCH), Hanoi, Vietnam. He is a Board member of Asia Pacific Society of Human Genetics since December 2012, Council member of Asia Pacific Pediatric Endocrine Society from 2010-2014, Board member of Asia Society of Inherited Metabolic Disease since 2013.

Dr. Dung was pediatric resident at the Medical Genetic Center of the Hospital Pediatrics of St. Antony, Catholic University of Lille, France. He was also the research fellow at Saint Louis University, MO, USA (2006–2009) and fellow at Royal children's Hospital, Melbourne, Australia. He was awarded the Pfizer Overseas Fellowship according to outstanding presentation for the Japanese Society for Inherited Metabolism Diseases in 2004.

Dr Dung received several awards including Travel Award to attend the 11th International Congress of Inborn Errors of Metabolism (ICIM) in San Diego, California, USA in 2009; Asian Investigator Award at the 53rd annual meeting of the Japanese Society for Inherited Metabolic diseases and the 10th annual symposium of the Asian Society for Inherited Metabolic diseases in 2011 in Chiba, Japan; The Award for Excellent Study of the joint meeting of the 2nd Asian Congress for Inherited Metabolic Diseases (ACIMD) & the 12th Asian-European Workshop on Inborn Errors of Metabolism in Seoul, Korea from in 2012. In January 2018, Dr Dung was appointed to be the Director of Center for Rare Diseases and Newborn Screening for NCH.
