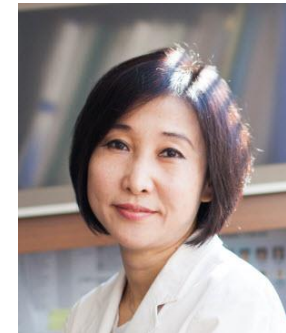

Professor Yun Sil Chang is the clinician-scientist, Professor of Pediatrics at Sungkyunkwan University, and a chief neonatologist at Samsung Seoul Hospital. Pf. Chang was a visiting scholar in Neonatal Brain Laboratory at UCSF, USA in 2003 for one year. She took up her current position at 2009, after obtaining her B.S., M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Seoul National University.

She is an editorial board member of “Neonatology” and “Journal of Korean Medical Science” and was an Editor-in-Chief of “Neonatal Medicine” (Official J of Korean Society of Neonatology).

She is now Secretary General of Korean Neonatal Network, Vice President of Seoul & Kyungin tributary of Korean Society of Neonatology in Korea.

She is a regular member of Neuroscience and Pediatric Research in USA.

Her research interest is a bench to bed side translational research regarding mesenchymal stem cells (MSC) for incurable neonatal diseases, such as bronchopulmonary dysplasia (BPD), severe intraventricular hemorrhage (IVH), and hypoxic-ischemic encephalopathy, etc.

Moreover, her group is conducting the first in human clinical trials, intratracheal MSC transplantation in premature infants for BPD and intraventricular MSC transplantation in extremely premature infants for severe IVH.

She published more than 120 articles in peer-review journals regarding neonatology and translational stem cell research.
